Departure of Africa bound for Haiti

After the world dash in favor of Haiti, and following the reactions of many States of Africa and of the African Union, it is to the turn of the people and of the intellectuals to imply themselves, by showing solidarity, without condescension, but with sincerity and spirit of continuation in the logic even of solidarity which order the strategic option of the United States of Africa in relation to the 6° area of the African Union.

Arrival: Port-au-Prince

Objectives: -1° To relieve the older sister of the African diasporas after the earthquake

-2° To affirm the presence of Africa resisting forces to the sides of the African Diasporas in fight

-3° To build the Bridge and to launch the footbridges beyond the seas and the oceans between the Motherland and the 6° area of the African Union

Method (S): To charter a boat armed and charged:

- nonperishable food products, doctors urgentists, psychologists of the catastrophes, construction materials, etc

- Artists, musicians, writers and men and women of culture of Africa and black world

- A ship of songs, dances, tales, of theatre, objects of arts and books and literature out of Africa I

Indeed, for Coordination, the balsam of Haiti and the African diasporas in particular, it is not only the specific assistance with the rebuilding or the hypocritical gifts of repurchase or bad conscience, but before all the Fraternity and the Solidarity of the heart and the spirit, by a strong symbol.

In order to support these initiatives, we propose :

-1° the opening of an Panafrican subscription campaign and universal contributions for the Rebuilding of Haiti

-2° the international mobilization, in african countries and among the African diasporas to require the payment of Repairs on behalf of the slave European powers, colonialists and imperialists for the crimes committed against Africa and Haiti in order to carry out the Rebuilding of Haiti.

-3° sending of a Delegation in Haiti to carry the Message of the peoples of Africa and African Intellectuals to the brothers and sisters of the Large island. Indeed, Haiti is not victim of nature, but strategic disarmament operated by the imperial powers at the place of this first independent black republic, which will have been released at the same time from slavery and the foreign domination, and which after having made supported the movements of emancipation of the countries of America with respect to the slave system and of the European domination, precociously gave to the whole world the example even of dignity of Freedom and the Democracy in the equality, thanks to Toussaint-Louverture and his/her comrades of combat.

We also call the Mobilization of Africa, the African Diasporas and the whole world for voluntary subscriptions and contributions in favor of the brothers and sisters of Haiti and with the tension forces for the payment of historical Repairs on behalf of the slave nations, in order to finance the Rebuilding of Haiti, and beyond, the rehabilitation of the bonds between Africa and its diasporas, within the framework of the panafricanism of our time and the United States of Africa.

On the whole, it is thus fully conscious of the need for reinforcing the links between the African diasporas and the people of the Continent, that the members of Coordinating Council intend to establish the moral, intellectual and cultural corridor between the peoples of Africa and those of the African diasporas. The present Campaign "a boat for Haiti" is ultimately our manner with us of redrawing the road of the Hope and of delivering the friendly and parenthood Message of Africa Motherland to her sons and girls on the other side of the Atlantic.
